

End the US blockade on Cuba!

Pres Biden: *get your knee off Cuba's neck!*

For 60 years US governments have enforced a vicious economic blockade on Cuba, attempting, in its words, “*to bring about hunger, desperation and overthrow of government.*”

Trump escalated this economic war with 243 new sanctions, plunging Cuba into a crisis made worse by covid-19, which has shut down tourism, a vital source of hard currency.

Breaking campaign promises, Pres. Biden has decided to continue Trump's policy of extreme aggression, aiming to turn economic crisis into political crisis by paying “dissidents” to organise protests—which fizzle out because Cuban people refuse to join in.

Biden is the latest US President to underestimate Cubans' resolve to defend their socialist revolution, reflected in the highest ratio of doctors to citizens and share of GDP spent on education of any country in the world.

Cuba's solidarity with other peoples in struggle is without parallel. Now it needs, and deserves, our solidarity!

On 23 June the UN General Assembly will vote—for the 29th time—to condemn the US blockade. The last vote, in 2019, was 187 to 3, with just Israel and Bolsonaro's Brazil siding with the USA. On the weekend of 19-20 June, protests will take place across the world demanding ***Hands off Cuba! End the blockade now!***
